

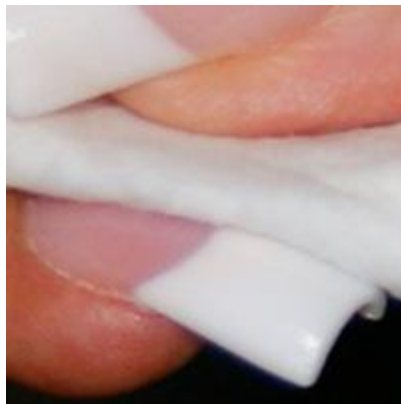
How To: Polish Change on Pink & White Acrylic Nails

"Keep your Pink & White Acrylic Nails like Brand New, for the entire time between Fill-Ins, with your Tammy Taylor Pink & White Polish Change Kit."

It is so easy to change the Polish on Pink & White Acrylic Nails:

1. Remove the (Clear Polish) Top Coat with Tammy Taylor Acetone base Polish Remover

2. File the acrylic nail (pay special attention to the cuticle area) use the Tammy Taylor "180-grit Zebra file"



3. Apply Tammy Taylor "Cuticle & Conditioning Oil" to the acrylic nail



4. **Buff the acrylic nail with the Tammy Taylor "Clean Finish Buffer" until smooth**



5. Wash hands
6. **Apply 2 Coats of Tammy Taylor "A+ Coat"**



(A+ Coat is an Air-Dry, Non-Yellowing, High Gloss (U.V.) Acrylic Sealer Top Coat, to Keep your Pink & White Acrylic Nails from Yellowing)



Lifting, Fill Lines, Peely's, Yellowing, Biting and Picking, can be eliminated, by doing a simple Polish Change in between Fill-Ins.
