If you are having a problem trying to think about what goals you would like to achieve, I have written down a few examples to get your creative juices going:

- Make client cards (make sure you have your clients full name, home address, Cell phone #, e-mail address and birthday) for every client.
- Follow up on all your new clients by mailing or e-mailing a little "Thank You" note or "Thank You" card.
- Write out Birthday cards for all your clients that have a Birthday this month, and have them ready so you can give it to them on their next appt. or mail it to them.
- Sign up for a Tammy Taylor Class.
- **Start promoting** your "Client Referral" program.
- Clean out your station.
- Organize your products by procedure: Acrylic nail Products in one basket, Manicure and Pedicure Products in another basket, etc...

You must have a Plan; the Plan doesn't have to be perfect, because if you wait till it's perfect, vou will never get started.

Remember, a Plan can only be perfected as you go, because so many things change daily in our family and business.

(We have to adapt our Plan daily, to keep it going!)

Or, if you are waiting for the perfect timing, Or, until you have enough money to get started: You

could be waiting forever and wasting today.

Just take **little baby steps**, **every day**, diligently working your Plan, and in 3 months **you will look back** and not believe **what you have accomplished**.

Learning "How to" do a full set of nails in under one hour, was a huge accomplishment for me. My first set of nails took 8 hours, and they all fell off, **but now I have the World's record** for the fastest set of nails in less than 20 minutes. I am so glad I didn't wait until I was perfect, to do another set of nails or I would still be waiting, 28 years later.
