

## A Pink & White Sculptured Nail applied with T.T. Nail Form

### Apply A Full Set of Sculptured Nails in Under 1 hour

1. **SANITIZE** - Tammy Taylor Sanitize is available in 5 fragrances: Giorgio™, Peach, Coconut, Vanilla and Gardenia. Start every procedure by sanitizing your hands first; then your clients.
2. **REMOVE POLISH** - (All 10) Tammy Taylor Acetone Polish Remover with conditioners is available in 4 fragrances: Peach, Coconut, Vanilla and Gardenia. Note: Non-Acetone Polish remover's can leave acrylic nails yellow, gummy, and messy.
3. **ETCH** - (All 10) The 100 grit T.T. Purple Terminator is the best file for etching. Proper etching will eliminate 75% of lifting.



3a. **ETCH** only the way the fingernail grows, from the cuticle to free-edge, until there is no shine on the nailplate. (All 10)



3b. To further insure no lifting, use the T.T. Pterygium Stone to push back excess cuticle and skin that has grown onto the nailplate. (All 10)



4. **DUST** - (All 10) Remove the particles from the nailplate with a plastic manicure brush. It is necessary to brush from cuticle to free-edge, until the fingernail is clean. This also helps eliminate lifting. Note: A cosmetic brush can spread germs as it cannot be properly disinfected.



5. **PRIME** - (All 10) Apply the T.T. Primer to fingernails and let them dry. This will dry out the oils and kill the germs on the fingernails. Do not use a pre-prime, it can cause lifting.

Note: The primer is a methacrylic acid. A half ounce bottle can prime 1,000 fingernails, so a very small amount is needed. Primer can cause irritation. Dab the primer brush on a towelette before priming, to remove excess. After priming, wipe primer brush before placing brush back in bottle to eliminate contamination. (Always keep Primer bottle in a Primer Holder.)



6a. **APPLY NAIL FORMS** - (All 10). Hold the form with thumbs facing client. Create a C-Curve in the form by rolling it up and down.



6b. Guide the form under free-edge with thumbs. Use a very light touch, keeping the C-Curve in the form while applying.



6c. Form properly applied.  
Note: If the form does not fit properly, it will be difficult to apply and the nail will break.



7. **REPRIME** - Apply 2nd coat of T.T. Primer, (one nail at a time). Just before applying acrylic. Note: If second coat of primer dries, a 3rd coat can be applied. Applying product while primer is still wet will help eliminate lifting.

## The Nailbed Determines Your Nail Form

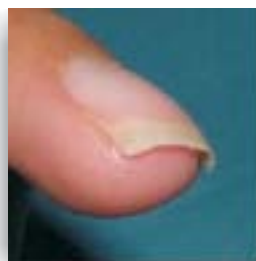
The Tammy Taylor forms are available in 3 different nailbed shapes: Original, Oval and Square. Also 2 different designs: Competitive Edge and Custom. The proper form will help eliminate breaking and cracking.

**(regular nailbed)**

**(high hyponychium)**

**(severe c-curve)**

**(flat nailbed)**

Pick the form that fits the shape of the nailbed.

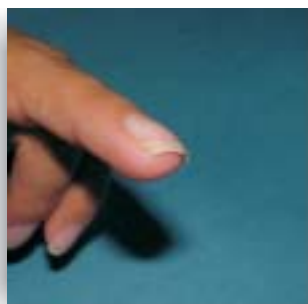
Note: If the form does not fit properly, it will be difficult to put on, and the acrylic nail will break easily.



**Gold: Competitive Edge Original**  
**A Regular nailbed needs a Gold Original nail form.**



**White: Competitive Edge Oval**  
**A Narrow nailbed or nailbed with a High hyponychium, needs a White Oval nail form.**



**Black: Competitive Edge Square**  
**A Flat nailbed needs a Black Square nail form, also a nailbed with a severe C-Curve needs a Black Square nail form.**

**Apply Product in 4-Balls**

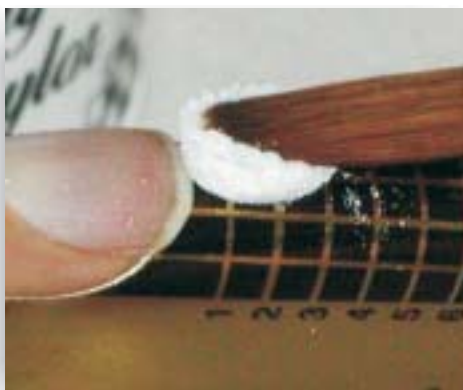
8. APPLY PRODUCT - The Tammy Taylor powders are available in 11 colors: Whitest White, Dramatic White and regular White; Pinkest Pink, Dramatic Pink, regular Pink, True Pink and Clear Pink; also Natural, Clear & Peaches n' Cream).

Product is applied in 4 balls. "Pat the White" and "Stroke the Pink": "1, 2, 3, 4". Use the T.T. Deep Ceramic Dappen Dish (Black for Liquid & White for Brush Cleaner) and a T.T. Custom brush. Tammy's brushes are available in 3 sizes: Original, Large & Small, and in 2 shapes: Custom and Flat.

Note: Apply all 4-balls to each fingernail, before going to next fingernail.



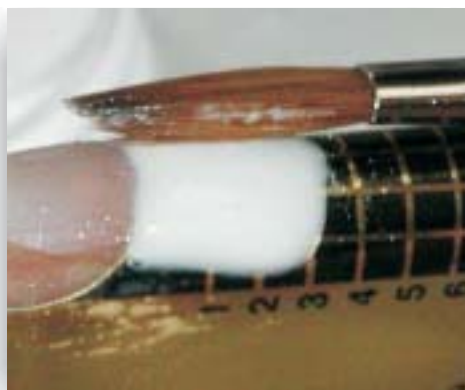
8-1a. # 1 Ball: make a T.T. White acrylic ball.



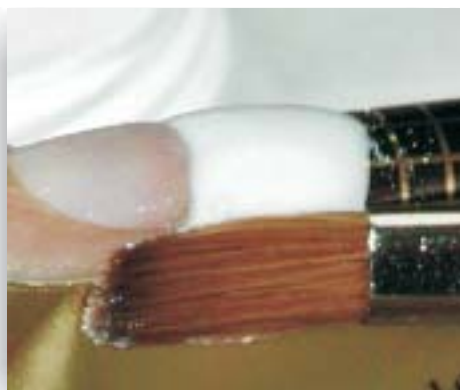
8-1b. Place #1 ball on the nail form to make the free-edge. Lift brush and let ball flow. (count 1-2-3)



8-1c. Pat across the nail from side to side.



8-1d. Push in the sides, lining the side of the free-edge up to the nail groove.



8-1e. Turn brush around and start the happy-face.



8-1f. Twirl brush inside of the happy-face, to create a crisp line.



8-1g. Even out tip of free-edge.

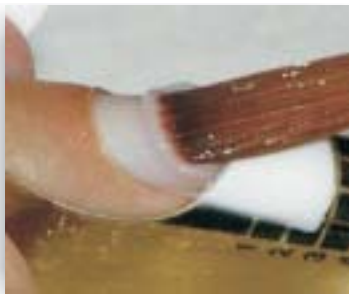
## 2nd Ball

Place 1/2 way down nailbed (Do not let the #2 ball touch the White free-edge ball until you start stroking, as this will cause your pink to run onto your white.)

PLACE ball - LIFT brush and let ball flow. (count 1-2-3) Stroke: (side-side-center)



8-2a. #2 Ball: make a wet T.T. Pink acrylic ball.



8-2b. Place #2 ball 1/2 way down nailbed.



8-2c. Lift brush and let #2 ball flow. (count 1-2-3)  
(Notice the space between the white free-edge and the pink ball.)



8-2d. Stroke #2 ball. (side-side-center).

## 3rd Ball: Cuticle area

Place 1/32nd of an inch away from the cuticle.

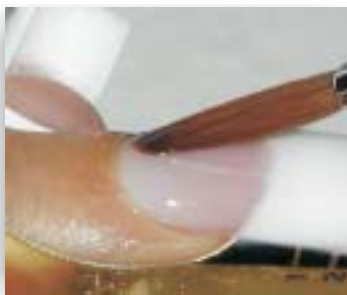
PLACE ball - LIFT brush and Let ball Flow. (count 1-2-3) Stroke: (side-side-center)



8-3a. #3 Ball: make a wet T.T. Pink ball.



8-3b. Place #3 ball 1/32nd of an inch away from the cuticle.  
Lift brush and let ball flow. (count 1-2-3)



8-3c. Stroke #3 ball. (side-side-center)



8-3d. Clean up around cuticle.

## 4th Ball: Stress area

Place between the 2nd and 3rd balls on the nailbed. This is to reinforce and strengthen the stress area of the nail.

PLACE ball - LIFT brush and Let ball Flow. (count 1-2-3) Stroke: (side-side-center)



8-4a. #4 Ball: make a wet T.T. Pink acrylic ball.



8-4b. Place #4 ball between #2 and #3 balls.  
Lift brush and let ball flow. (count 1-2-3)



8-4c. Stroke #4 ball. (side-side-center)



Pinch the C-Curve when the acrylic nail is not shiny, but still flexible. This will make the acrylic nail very strong.

5-Steps in Filing



9-1. (All 10) #1 Step in filing: File the left side of free-edge using the 100-grit T.T. Purple Terminator file.



9-2. (All 10) #2 Step in filing: File the right side of the free-edge using the 100-grit T.T. Purple Terminator file.



9-3a. (All 10) #3 Step in filing: File the tip of the free-edge using the 100-grit T.T. Purple Terminator file.



9-4a. (All 10) #4 Step in filing: File the Cuticle and Contour area, using the T.T. Long Lasting Zebra 180-grit file.

Contour the acrylic nail by beveling up one side of the acrylic nail, across the top and bevel down the other side, using the exclusive Tammy Taylor "Horseshoe Pattern", continue the same motion all the way to the free-edge.

9-4b. Road - File around cuticle area making sure there is a little road between the acrylic and the cuticle skin.

9-3b. Tilt file to get the desired shape:

90 degree angle	= Square	
45 degree angle	= Square-Oval	
almost flat	= Oval	

File back and forth across the tip of the free-edge until the desired shape is achieved.



9-5. (All 10) #5 Step in filing: Client's Angle. Use the T.T. Long Lasting Zebra 180-grit file and file the client's angle. File while pointing client's fingertips towards them, look down the same angle the client will be looking down. The client will be looking at this angle for the next two weeks, it must look good to them!



10a. BUFF - (All 10). Apply T.T. Conditioning Cuticle Oil to the acrylic nail and cuticles. (Available in 8 different fragrances: Peach, Vanilla, Gardenia, Coconut, Opium, Poison, Giorgio™ and Beautiful.)



10b. Then buff with the T.T. Clean Finish Buffer (Block or File) to smooth acrylic nail and remove scratches.



10c. (optional) Shine (all 10) with the T.T. Super Soft Shiner.

11. WASH HANDS - Squirt a small amount of the T.T. fragrant shampoo (available in Peach, Mango and Pineapple) on a manicure brush and hand it to the client to wash their hands. A little squirt of T.T. Peach Scrub is also a nice touch. This is also an excellent way to build retail sales. Clients will buy the items that you feel confident to use.

12. POLISH - (All 10). Apply the A-Coat (a liquid plastic U.V. inhibitor applied like polish); to keep the acrylic nails Pink and White. Then apply Z-Coat (a Super Shiny non-yellowing top-coat), to protect the A-Coat from various cosmetics and sunscreens. Note: Also use Z-Coat over Color polish.
